Celebrate Creativity

Please Read Carefully

The countdown is on. . . We very much look forward to your school's participation in this year's Street Painting Festival. We are trying some different things this year, so please read this carefully. We hope you and your students have a great time.

This year, there are four team categories: Intermediate, middle, high school and mixed grade; please assign each of your teams to one of these. There is a **\$30 per team registration fee due no later than April 1, 2019**, to assure space at the Festival. Whether the school pays the fee or charges the students is up to each school.

About the Festival: By participating, you agree and accept the following:

1. There is no theme this year. We ask you to celebrate creativity and surprise us, but all art is to be **portrait** orientation.
2. You may choose to check-in and start your work between **1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. on Friday (4/26)**. The Festival will not start until Saturday, but there may be adult artists beginning their work on Friday. **Saturday check-in will be 8:00 a.m.** On both days, check-in will be in the Center for the Arts at Kayenta in the middle of Kayenta Art Village. When you get to the Art Village, come to the Center for the Arts to get your square assignment, hand in your paperwork (if not submitted previously) and get your chalk. You must submit a signed permission slip for each participating student.
3. All teams need to have an adult with them, but he/she need not be a teacher. You may have a parent or other adult chaperone your team(s). It is your responsibility, however, to inform each parent of who will chaperone the child's team.
4. Judging of school team art will be on Saturday at **3:00 p.m.** Your art will be judged at whatever stage of creativity it appears as of that time. Awards will be announced at **3:30 on Saturday**.

5. Your square will be marked out for you—**portrait orientation**.
6. There will be an outdoor wash basin near the Center for the Arts. Please have students use this to wash up. Students must wash before entering the Center for any reason.
7. If you need water, chalk, or other supplies or have questions during the Festival, please check with Festival staff at the Center for the Arts.
8. Water will be available throughout the day near the Center for the Arts.
9. Please bring tarps, sunscreen and other materials to protect students and art; April weather is tricky. KAF is not able to provide these items.
10. If you want to bring a white canopy, you may, but you are responsible for its setup and care during the Festival. KAF reserves the right for any reason to ask you not to use the canopy. If you elect to draw on Friday, please remove the canopy when you leave whether you will return on Saturday.
11. Participation is at your own risk and you accept the square assigned to you and the venue as is.
