The November 2021 Exhibit is open to 2-D and 3-D artworks comprised of mostly natural materials such as clay, fiber, fabric, etc. Artists may showcase woven/quilted hangings, wheel-thrown/hand-built pottery, and sculptures. (Wall art must have a rod or wire across the back or top, suitable for hanging on our hook system.)

The theme is "From the Earth: Fiber and Ceramics"

Wednesday, October 27th from 3 – 6:00 PM.

There will be an opening reception on Wednesday, November 3rd from 6:30 - 8:00 PM at the Center for the Arts at Kayenta.

This show will end Wednesday, December 29th. Unsold entries can be picked up that day between 3:00 and 6:00 PM. Please do not retrieve your work before that date. (If you are unable to pick it up on that date, send written permission for a friend to pick it up for you.)

Art will be on display to the public during regular staff business hours (Monday – Friday 12:00 – 4:00 PM), and during scheduled performances.

Center for the Arts at Kayenta Exhibits

ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

- Entries are limited to two (2) pieces of ORIGINAL work (no giclees, serigraphs, or other commercial reproductions).
- Entry fee is \$5 per piece (non-refundable). CHECKS or CASH accepted--no credit cards, VENMO, etc.
- All exhibit entries must have a title. NO EXCEPTIONS. ("Untitled #1" is not an acceptable title.)

JURY

- Entries will be pre-juried by a committee of professional artists as to suitability for inclusion in each show. (If your piece is not juried in, it must be picked up before the exhibit opens.)
- A different committee will jury each show, allowing for different perspectives and tastes in the selection of artworks.

FRAMING INFORMATION

All artwork intended for hanging must have the appropriate **wire hangers** to safely accommodate the weight of the piece. (This includes fiber pieces.) The Center for the Arts at Kayenta will not be responsible for damage or repairs if your work does not meet this requirement.

SALES

- All entries must be for sale. (Exception: Youth may have work that is not for sale; please mark it "NFS.")
- Work sold during the show may not be removed from the show until the show has ended.
- The Center will not be responsible for shipping art. Buyers who want art shipped must negotiate shipping with the artist.
- The Center for the Arts at Kayenta will handle all sales of work at the show. A 25% commission
 will be retained on all sales.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSS OR DAMAGE/INSURANCE COVERAGE

The Center for the Arts at Kayenta shall be responsible for the safekeeping of all artwork while they are in the custody of the Center.

The Center shall be liable to the artist for loss of damage (except for damage resulting in flaws inherent in the artwork) to the percentage as outlined below, of the artist's commission, had the artworks been sold:

\$1.00 - \$999.00 -- 50% coverage \$1,000 - \$1,999 -- 75% coverage \$2,000 and above -- 95% coverage

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION OF ART

- Artists will be responsible for delivering artworks IN PERSON to the Center by a pre-determined deadline. (No shipping.)
- Artists will be responsible for picking up any unsold art IN PERSON at the end of a show by a
 predetermined deadline. (No shipping.) Please, NO EARLY PICKUPS! If you cannot pick up your
 work on the assigned date, send a friend with written permission to collect it.

By entering your work, you agree to abide by the rules set forth above.
